For regular activities, we would arrange setting for more individual space; we would discourage personal contact and suggest washing hands frequently. The RCD is performing enhanced cleaning on high traffic and high contact areas at the centre on a daily basis.

To protect yourself and others, we ask that anyone who is feeling unwell or suspect or know that you have been in contact with someone infected with COVID-19, should refrain from visiting us so that together we can ensure a safe and comfortable experience for everyone.

While the Public Health Agency of Canada has assessed the current public health risk associated with coronavirus as low, we continue to monitor for developments very closely. It is important to acknowledge that many of our participants (and staff members) may be at greater risk for serious symptoms should they be infected with COVID-19.
