RDSP Facts

- For Canadian resident under the age of 60 and are eligible for the Disability Tax Credit
- Having an RDSP does not impact Federal Benefits
- In BC, money in an RDSP does not impact existing provincial social assistance support
- You may be eligible to receive annual grants of up to \$3,500 depending on your contribution and family income
- Even with no financial contribution, you may be eligible to receive up to \$1,000 every year for up to 20 years
- New provisions of **Carry Forward** & **Roll Over!!!**
