Learn more about this new federally registered savings plan delivered by the Government of Canada

- Having an RDSP does not impact Federal Benefits
- In BC, money in an RDSP does not impact existing provincial social assistance support programs
- You may be eligible to receive annual grants of up to \$3,500 depending on your contribution and family income
- Even with no financial contribution, you may be eligible to receive up to \$1,000 every year of up to 20 years
- New provisions of **Carry Forward & Roll Over!!!**
