Volunteer has to appear in person

- Complete the necessary "Consent & Disclosure Form"
- Requires one photo ID, such as passport, driver license or BC ID card; and one other ID, such as care card, SIN card, birth certificate; for some proof of residence
- A photocopy of your Volunteer Agreement or job description or similar document
- Name, title, phone number of employer to forward the criminal record check report
- Fee is waived for volunteer, except for Vancouver Police Department (\$25)

Procedures

- 1. Go to the RCMP office in jurisdiction of your residence and request for a criminal record check.
- 2. Tell the officer that you are volunteering for the Richmond Centre for Disability, which is a non-profit organization in Richmond.
- 3. The program you are going to volunteer for is summer camp for children and youth with special needs.
- 4. Your criminal record should be forwarded directly to:

- 5. There should be no cost incurred in this (except for Vancouver \$25).
- 6. The report of your criminal record check is strictly confidential and for the reference of the Centre only.
