

YOU CAN HELP THE RCD SUMMER CAMP – BRING YOUR CHILD'S ACCESS 2 CARD



The Access 2 Card, issued to people with disabilities under the Access 2 Entertainment Program, is a personalized card that enables an attendant to receive a free ticket when visiting a theatre, some attractions and recreational facilities.

The RCD Summer Camp will go to movie theatre 3 times, visit Science World and the Aquarium for field trip activities. The Access 2 Card can help alleviate the financial burden of the program by allowing the staff and volunteers to receive free admission.

If your child already has an Access 2 Card:

- Check that the Access 2 Card has not expired; there is a five-year expiry for each card
- ◆ Give it to your child to bring along to the summer camp field trip, or
- ◆ Give it to Summer Camp staff on the field trip day

If your child does not have an Access 2 Card:

- ◆ Use the enclosed signed application form to apply for one
- ◆ You will receive a form with the Parent Info Package if you have indicated on the registration form that your child does not have the card, or
- ◆ You can ask for a signed form from Ella at RCD (ella@rcdrichmond.org or call 604-232-2404)
- ◆ It will take 4-6 weeks for delivery

Please note that there is a \$20 fee to acquire the Access 2 Card. The card will be valid for 5 years and can be used at all Access 2 Card Partners.
