If you are having difficulty getting to the library...

At Richmond Public Library, we provide home delivery service of library materials to disabled, elderly, and homebound customers who are unable to visit the library.

Home Services delivery is available to any person in Richmond, no matter what age, who is confined to their home, a residential care facility, seniors' housing or hospital because of physical or visual disability, injury or illness lasting more than three months.

We can provide you with regular and large print books as well as audio books and DAISY discs. We also have fifteen Plectalk Readers (Digital Book Readers) that may be borrowed for up to four months.

How does Home Services Delivery work?

Deliveries are made once a month to each customer on a Tuesday, Wednesday or Thursday, depending where in Richmond you live. Let Home Services know what kind of stories you prefer, and we will do our best to provide you with the kind of books you will enjoy reading. We are happy to fill special requests as well!

How do I register?

The Library's Audio Books service provides special library materials such as taped-book sets, books on MP3 CD and DAISY discs of full-length books. Audio Books are available to those Richmond residents who are unable to read regular print due to a visual or physical disability.

Please register with us first by calling **604-231-6406**. Audio books can be borrowed in the library or we can arrange for Home Service delivery if you are homebound.
