Rear Window Captioning® / Descriptive Video Service® Information

Rear Window Captioning® and Descriptive Video Service® are two systems implemented in select Canadian theatres of Cineplex Entertainment for guests with audio or visual disabilities and are available by demand during certain movie showings.

Description:

Rear Window Captioning® (RWC): RWC provides subtitles for deaf, deafened, or hard of hearing guests by broadcasting captions through a pixel-board at the back of the theatre which are then reflected onto portable, transparent, acrylic panels. The panels are inserted onto the patron's cup holder, effectively displaying the subtitles right in front of his/her seat without disturbing surrounding guests.

(Note: caption size depends on the location of the patron within the theatre. The closer the patron is to the back of the theatre, the larger the size of the subtitles.)

Descriptive Video Service® (DVS): DVS provides an audio description of movie events by way of removable headphones and are suitable for blind or visually impaired guests. DVS is available by request at the same locations that provide RWC services.

Currently, RWC®/DVS® are only provided in Cineplex theatres and are not available at every movie showing.
